WHO WE'RE LOOKING FOR:

Our ideal candidate has a Masters of Library and Information Science (MLIS) or equivalent university degree and experience in Libraries and/or programming with children and families, and young adults. You will also have a minimum of four years of Library programming experience, with an emphasis on coaching and mentoring a team of staff in the development and delivery of high-quality, literacy and STEAM/STEM focused programming. Significant knowledge of Library programming trends including Makerspace equipment, robotics, coding and educational technologies is an asset.

You will have training and experience in collection development and work alongside a team of selectors to manage the children's collections, both physical and digital. You will

also mentor and guide staff to ensure appropriate readers' advisory and public access to the children's and young adult collection, which includes overseeing curated book bags, promotional displays and lists, and the selection of databases and electronic resources.

While being a creative, ideas-person, your superior leadership and organizational skills ensure you are capable of balancing projects with multiple priorities involving various working groups and partners in a dynamic, fast-paced, customer-focused environment. Your commitment to the position requires flexibility to work both remotely and at all branches of the library system, including evenings and weekends.
