PURPOSE

To set the eligibility for participation and outline the parameters of the Home Library Service offered by Innisfil ideaLAB & Library to residents.

POLICY

General

Home Library Service provides free home delivery of books and other library materials by designated volunteers.

Application

This policy applies to all Staff and volunteers who facilitate the Home Library delivery service and to all recipients of the service.

Guidelines

Eligibility

This service is available to any person within the Town of Innisfil who is confined to their home or a health care institution because of a temporary or chronic disability.

Service

The following materials may be borrowed:

- Books large print, paperbacks, etc.;
- Audio books;
- Magazines current issues excepted;
- Other formats/materials, subject to Management approval.

Delivery

Materials will be delivered by designated volunteers based on an approved schedule, which is always contingent upon Health and Safety best practices and safe travelling conditions.

Volunteers

All volunteer drivers will be recruited according to the Library's current Volunteer Policy and will be expected to adhere to all Library policies and procedures and applicable legislation.

Police Records Checks

As part of its due diligence, the Library Board requires that all volunteers who may interact directly with children and/or vulnerable adults must provide a vulnerable sector check prior to working with these groups. These volunteers will be re-screened every two years.
