

Welcome to your Library

Welcome to Innisfil! One of the benefits of living in our community is that you can use the Library for free. Public Libraries are funded by taxes and anyone who lives, works, studies or owns property in Innisfil is eligible for a free Library card. If you lose your card, there is a \$5 charge to replace it.

Information for Library Users

You will need to show personal identification with a current home address to get a library card. The type of identification can include a driver's licence, piece of mail, or a lease/purchase agreement.

For children aged 14 years or younger, a parent/guardian must complete a form accepting responsibility for the child's usage and return of Library materials, this includes fees for any lost or damaged items.

Fine-free Service

Basic service is free. You may borrow any Library material for a loan period set by the Library.

Materials will renew automatically prior to their return date, if no one else has reserved them. You will receive a notification letting you know when to return your items. Most materials have no late fees, however once materials are 3 weeks overdue, replacement fees will be charged. Upon returning your materials, the replacement fees will be deleted. Fees are charged for damaged items.

Books

We have books for learning, entertainment and experiences. The Library staff is available to help you. Ask them for help, or request a tour of the library.

You can manage your account online or by downloading our Library App, log in with your Library card number and password. If you've forgotten your password, please contact us. From your account you can reserve items, renew loans, and create lists and book reviews.

When your items are ready to pick up, you'll receive a notification. You will have one week from notification to collect your holds.

Other Materials

You will also find DVDs, video games, magazines, large print books and books on CD. Take home a robot, board game, portable internet hotspots, video and audio equipment, and even gardening tools from our **Library of Things**.

Programs

Engaging activities take place in the Library for residents of all ages, children's programs include storytimes, crafts, games, technology, and more. Programs for adults and seniors include author visits, computer classes, book clubs, special guests, and more. Most programs are free or low cost and may require registration.

The Library also has a HackLAB which is a Maker Space where the public can learn to use new technology through workshops known as "Tinkershops." Some of the technology available in this space includes a laser cutter, vinyl cutter, 3D printer, recording studio, green screen, and more.

Joining Library programs is a great way to learn new skills, learn more about the community and meet new people.
